HOW TO ACCEPT US ENTRIES AT EQUESTRIAN CANADA COMPETITIONS

All US competitors and owners must hold a valid membership with the USEF as well as being a member in good standing. The link below goes directly to the USEF resource page for competition organizers.

Member Status Search (USEF Website):

You can search by name or USEF license number. It will list the following information for the individual:

1. License number
2. Name
3. Suspended members will be listed in a colour as outlined below
4. Amateur, Junior or Professional (must be declared when membership is purchased)
5. Senior or Junior member (only two options)
6. State
7. Discipline
8. Affiliated memberships (for example: USHJA Active)
9. FEI Affiliation (will state FEI Registered and FEI ID number)
10. If they have not renewed their license it will state INACTIVE



IF A PERSON'S NAME SHOWS UP IN COLOR, IT IS FOR ONE OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

11. **Magenta = Medical Suspension:** Contact the USEF office prior to the start of the competition - those listed may not participate as a rider, driver, handler, or other competitor, though they may be present on the competition grounds and may participate in other ways (e.g. as an owner, trainer, etc.).
12. **Green = Suspended from the privilege of taking any part whatsoever as Manager/Management at a Recognized Competition.**
13. **Blue = Suspended from the privilege of taking any part as an Official whatsoever at a Recognized Competition.**
14. **Red = Suspended from the privilege of taking any part whatsoever in any Recognized Competition, not allowed on competition grounds.**

The following information will be listed:

1. Horses Name & ID number
2. Foal Date
3. Breed
4. Colour
5. Sire/Dam
6. Membership Type (options: Life, Horse ID Only, Retired,
7. Breed Registry number (if applicable)
8. Owner Information
9. Farm Owner Information (if Applicable)
10. Affiliate membership (e.g. USHJA registered)
11. FEI Information (FEI passport number, current registration, etc.)



Foreign Affidavit

The Foreign Affidavit must be completed for all non-Canadian owned horses that do not have an EC or FEI passport. This document is found in the Competition Document Package sent upon approval.

HOW TO ACCEPT US ENTRIES AT EQUESTRIAN CANADA COMPETITIONS

Exceptions for CET and Amateur

A902.6 - Amateur Competitors (Section A, General Regulations, Chapter 9)

USEF members who are eligible to compete as amateurs are eligible to compete in EC amateur classes, except in CET and EC amateur medal classes when they must also pay the fee for a valid Sport License and be members of the CET as required by the class specifications. Proof of amateur status must be submitted with entries to EC-sanctioned competitions.
